September 2024 - December 2024

You said:	We did:
You wanted a dedicated space for Hair & Beauty Qualifications	Led by Wayne, the Construction learners built a new room for Hair & Beauty; other staff supported this by working late evenings and weekends; Julian and Lisa funded the equipment, and the room was opened on 5 th December 2024
A number of you asked for lunches to be provided and expressed an interest in developing cookery skills as part of independent living but you were worried as there was no freezer on-site; and there was limited equipment	A freezer has been purchased along with other equipment such as more crockery, cutlery, and other kitchen equipment. Julie has been an angel and has deepcleaned the entire kitchen and has labelled all cupboards. The majority of learners now have a hot meal each day, and we are getting into a routine of meal planning and preparation and this will be even better in the New Year now that the routine has been established and Libby has agreed to support Learners in this area
You said that there was nowhere to eat lunches and that the middle room was a mess	With the help of staff the entire learning zone building has been cleaned, tidied and broken equipment has been removed. We have purchased some new multi-functional furniture, which provides not only a social space for eating but also some additional learning

You told us that it was important to you to have your mobile phones with you and for staff to trust that you would agree to the 'rules' for this	space. The furniture that has been removed is in storage and we will work with you over the coming months to look at how we may further improve areas across the site You worked with staff to devise a mobile phone contract, and you all signed up to this. Unfortunately, as the weeks have progressed the use of phones during non-phone time has increased and you have several days to turn this around otherwise this will need to be reviewed in January and we may to revert to the MIAG policy of no phones on site, this is something that we do not wish to do as we know how important this is to you but we cannot have the level of disruption and silliness that we have

This will be a system where good behaviour or excellent examples of progress can be seen. Staff will be implementing this early in the New Year and will ensure that you all know how you can earn these rewards and how the system works
You have asked for the outdoor area to be more welcoming	We are working to create some nice spaces outside of the learning blocks and you will start to see some changes late in the Spring. Creating outdoor space is weather dependent so we will have to wait of the nicer days to come but we are committed to ensuring that this space looks and feels better for the summer months so you can all enjoy some outdoor time.
